Our main goal this summer at Simcha Day Camp is to be *שמיימ* *שם מקדש* in whatever we are doing. Both in the classrooms and out, on the courts and fields, during trips, and at the pool. Davening nicely, learning well and always acting with good middos are what make up a Simcha Day Camp camper and we should always be a source of *קידוש ה'*.

Rav Chaim Kanievsky Brings the following thought on this week's Parsha.

The Torah tells us about the stick of Aharon that was placed before Hashem,

ויצא פרה ויצניץ ציץ ויגמל שקדים

It brought forth a blossom, sprouted a bud and almonds ripened.

This stick was put away for the generations to show the incredible *נס* that happened with a lifeless piece of wood that sprouted almonds.

The question is why did this match that was put away as a reminder for future generations have to have the buds and blossoms that lasted well into the time of the first Bais Hamikdash.

Wasn't the main point that it grew almonds?

Tosfos Yeshanim explains that normally when almonds grow on the tree they grow months after the flowers and buds are gone.

Had it just been a branch of almonds it would not be apparent that there was a *נס* here. By seeing the flowers and buds, all generations can see that the different stages of growth that had transpired.

Appreciating growth and it's stages is what had to be memorialized for eternity.

We anticipate looking back one day at Summer 2022 and appreciating it as a summer of great growth in both Ruchniyos and Gashmiyus bez"H.

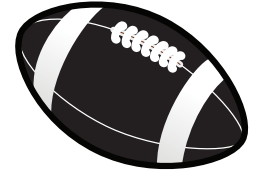
This is such an awesome group of guys, and I'm so so pumped to continue to get to know each and every one of you!

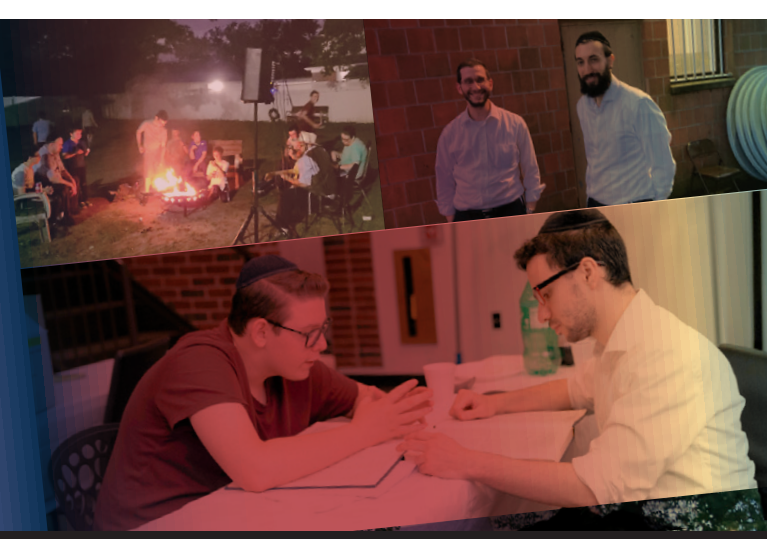
