# Torah B'Simcha

## בלק

Each morning we preface our davening with the following פסוק which is also prominently displayed at the top of a column in this week's Parsha:

“מה־טבו אהליך יַעֲקֹב מִשְׁפְּנוֹתֶיךָ יִשְׂרָאֵל”

How nice are your tents, Israel, your places, Yaakov!

Wait!! Who uttered this statement? It was none other than a non-Jew and vicious anti-Semite, named בַּלְעָם!! If so, what are we doing quoting such a person and prominently displaying it in the Torah?

Perhaps this is because this is a compliment to us from one who was trying to find fault with us, but nevertheless, could only see greatness in us!

What did he see that prompted such praise?

On answer our sages give is he was lauding our prayers - our tents, originally the מִשְׁכָּן, then the בֵּית הַמִּקְדָּשׁ, and now our מִעֻט מִקְדָּשׁ. He praised how we pour out our hearts to Hashem. We realize that all comes from Him and is in His hands and so we turn to Him, for only He can provide...

Another answer is that he saw our learning places. He

saw how we devote substantial portions of our lives to delve into the depths of the Torah and grow in Hashem's ways! This deserves special comment for others do not see a reason to do so, and so...

Rashi says that he saw how our tents were arranged in a way that no occupant of one tent can spy upon the other. “We minded our own business.” This created great אַהֲדוּת and we learn that if we have אַהֲדוּת, no-one can inflict harm upon us!! If so, how apropos is the approbation of בַּלְעָם...

Gear up for the playoffs starting on Monday!! We only know how to do sports one way here-intense!

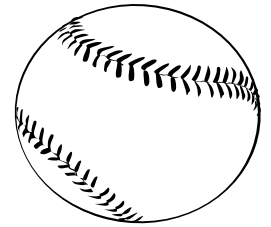
We had a great trip to Season's Express as well, where everybody had a great time trying to guess my age. Thank you to all who guessed 18-You guys are great!!
