

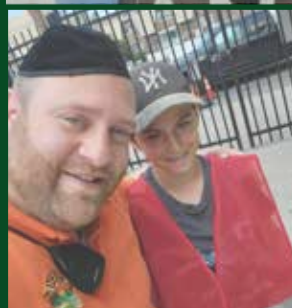

Torah B'Simcha

פרשת ואתחנן

Every man has two hundred and forty eight limbs. It is brought down, על פי קבלה, that the words of the קריאת שמע give support to these limbs. This is because of the number of words in the Shema. The problem is that the Shema has only two hundred and forty seven words. Where do we get the extra word from?

The answer is, that this is why we add the word אמת to the Shema. The word אמת is really part of the next part of ברכות קריאת שמע. By adding the word אמת, we now have two hundred and forty eight words, enough to sustain the limbs of the body.

The דגל מחנה אפרים explains, that this is hinted to in פרשת ואתחנן. Interestingly, the first part of שמע is in this week's Parsha as well. Where do we find the idea of adding אמת to the שמע?

The פסוק says, "וְאַתֶּם הַדְּבָקִים בְּה' אֱלֹהֵיכֶם תִּיִם", "and you who attach yourselves to Hashem,

you are alive today". The simple understanding of this פסוק is that by clinging to Hashem we are considered to be alive in the most complete sense.

The דגל מחנה אפרים, says that we derive something else from this פסוק as well. The letters of the word "וְאַתֶּם", can be reordered and read as, "וְאַמֶּת", meaning, "and אמת". The above פסוק would then be read as, "and אמת, when it is attached to ה' אֱלֹהֵיכֶם, you are alive today." The last words of the Shema are, "ה' אֱלֹהֵיכֶם." When we add אמת to these words than we are alive, because through the two hundred and forty eight words, we sustain ourselves.

Although the full meaning of these ideas are complex and based on the secrets of קבלה, one thing is clear. Our תפילות have tremendous power, and they do indeed sustain us. Let us have this in mind as we prepare to daven.
